Sir,

With reference to your letter No.CHSM/PB/P-
RECOG/99/2035 dated 28.7.99 on the subject cited above, I am
directed to say that the Executive Committee of this Council in
its meeting held on 27.3.2000 considered the matter in the light
of reports of inspection and it allowed the extension of
recognition to the colleges namely Homoeopathic Medical College,
Chandigarh; Institute of Post Graduate Homoeopathic Medical
Education, Mohali Homoeopathic Medical College, Abohar and Sri
Guru Nanak Dev Homoeopathic Medical College, Ludhiana from
2000-2001 onwards to take admission of students in B.H.M.S.
Direct and Graded Degree Courses as per admission capacity
conveyed previously subject to the condition that they shall
remove the insufficiencies reflected in the respective report of
inspection and send the inspection fees in prescribed time limit
and further strengthen all the requisite facilities as per
Homoeopathy (Minimum Standards of Education) Regulations, 1983.

The Executive Committee after considering the report of
inspection did not recognise/allow the Homoeopathic Medical
College, Hoshiarpur because it does not meet the minimum require-
ments, norm and standards for running B.H.M.S.-Degree Course. It
also noted that this college has yet not remitted the inspection
fees.

The Executive Committee noted with regret that Lord Mahavira Homoeopathic Medical College, Ludhiana has not provided the requisite facilities for imparting clinical teaching and training to the students to the satisfaction of the Central Council as seen from the Inspection Report. While allowing the college its recognition for the session 2000-2001 it decided that the college may be asked to take remedial measures to rectify the short falls indicated in the inspection report and also strengthen the clinical teaching facilities within six months, and it will be reinspected by this Council immediately after receipt of compliance report accompanied by a fresh request for extension of recognition.
